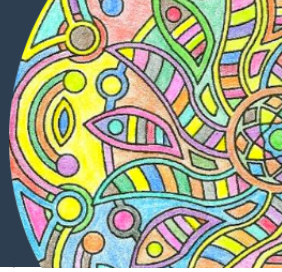

- 2,000+ Candles lit in prayer

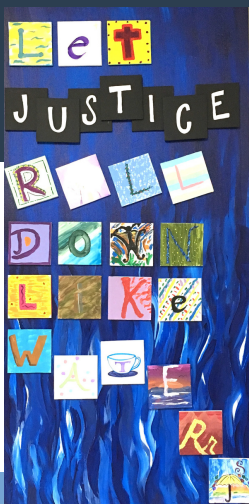

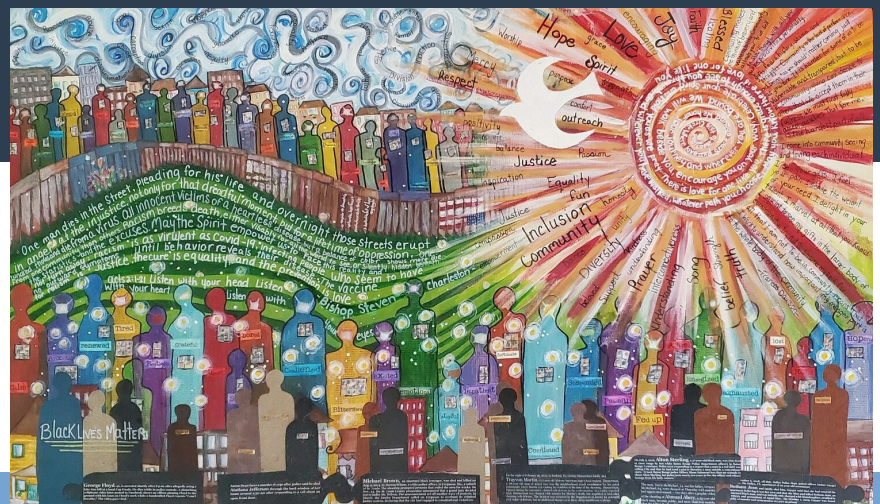


ELECTION WEEK PRAYER LABYRINTH
